This chapter from the South Ogden City, Utah History book continues to talk about the Mayors of South Ogden.

Mayor Doren B. Boyce 1950 - 1957

Doren Benjamin Boyce, third mayor of South Ogden City, was a dynamic, hard working official, possessing strong leadership qualities and able to get along with fellow city officials and residents. His two four-year terms that began in 1950 covered the city's major periods of growth in municipal services and community development.

He was born July 1, 1914, in Salt Lake City. When it came time to give him a name, his father wanted Doren while his mother felt he should be named after his father, Benjamin. So they ceremoniously named him Doren Benjamin Boyce, immediately after which his father called him "Pete".

Louis Hoggan 1958 - 1961

Louis Hoggan, an auspicious, outstanding man with deep-set dark brown eyes, contagious smile and a friendly, handshake. He served as a city council member for ten years before running for mayor.

Mr. Hoggan owned one of the most beautiful homes in South Ogden in 1937, located on Chimes View Drive. He moved from Ogden to South Ogden because his wife wanted to rear their family in a rural atmosphere and South Ogden, with its view of the lofty mountains on the east and beautiful sunsets in the west, provided the perfect location, in addition to having good neighbors, being close to his work, church, and the schools.

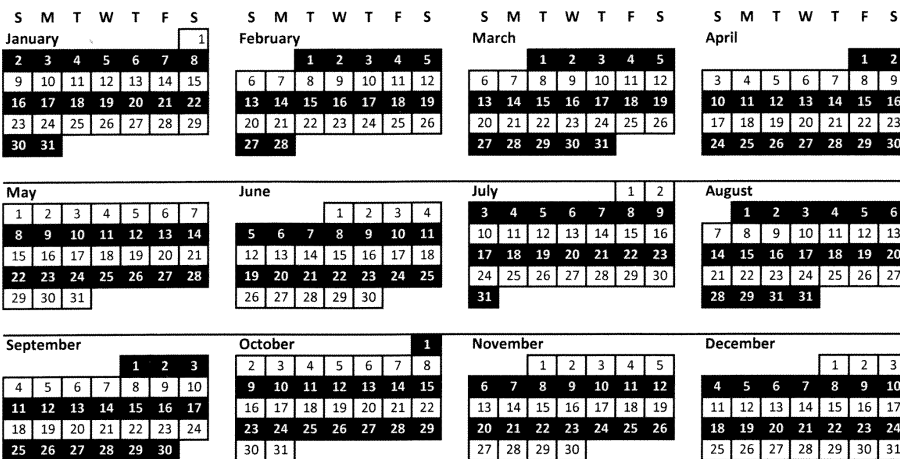

Items that can be recycled:

- Newspapers, magazines, phone books, office paper, junk mail, shredded paper (in bags)
- Tin and aluminum cans
- All number 1 & 2 plastics in bottle form
- Corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes, paper egg cartons, brown grocery bags, plastic film
- Small appliances (irons, toaster, pots and pans, cookware, metal clothes hangers, copper, brass and scrap aluminum)

Items that cannot be recycled:

- Glass (any kind)
- Motor oil bottles, yard waste, paint cans, wood
- Bathroom waste (paper towels & tissue, diapers)
- Aluminum foil, microwavable cardboard, food stained material
- Styrofoam, bubble wrap, packing peanuts
- Plastic toys

South Ogden Cleanup Program and Mixed/Green Waste Trailer/Rolloff Rentals will begin April 4, 2011. Prices for the trailer/rolloff are \$45.00/\$55.00 for a green waste trailer/rolloff and \$80.00/\$100.00 for a mixed waste trailer/rolloff. A \$100.00 deposit is required with each rental. The Neighborhood Cleanup Program requires a \$100 deposit plus five signatures from your neighbors who will be participating in the cleanup. The \$100 deposit check will be cashed and a refund check will be issued within 14 days of dumping of the trailer/rolloff, unless any of the rules stated on the application are violated. The application and fees need to be turned in to the Public Works Department located at 5590 S 600 E and must be received at least 48 hours prior to delivery. South Ogden Public Safety Department

From the Police Department: With the tax season upon us, many of us are racing to the ATM to get that extra few dollars the IRS has deposited to our accounts. The ATM has become such a way of life to us. It's also a great way for a criminal to score some cash. While you are using the ATM, either the walk-up or drive-up, be aware of your surroundings. It's very easy for us to become engrossed in what we are doing and let our guard down. This is when we are the most vulnerable to thieves.

When you are using the ATM, look around you. Watch for suspicious persons that might walk up behind you or to the side of you. Watch the parking lot as you are walking to the ATM. Make sure someone isn't watching you.

If you use a walk-up ATM, don't leave your car running. Turn it off and lock it. This will enable you to hear what is going on around you. A car running could also be enticing to a thief that wants not only your money, but your car!

Don't share your personal banking information with anyone! Don't let anyone else see the PIN you are using to access your account.

Make your transaction quick and small. The longer you stay at the ATM and the more money you receive, the more opportunity you give someone to steal your cash. Don't visibly count your cash while walking away from the machine. You don't want anyone else seeing your money. Don't forget your card!

If an ATM looks odd, or it doesn't act appropriately when trying to insert your card, don't use it! There are devices that can be installed on the machine that will track and keep your personal information for a thief to use at a later date.

Remember... be safe, be smart.
