## Ghouls and Goblins Festival

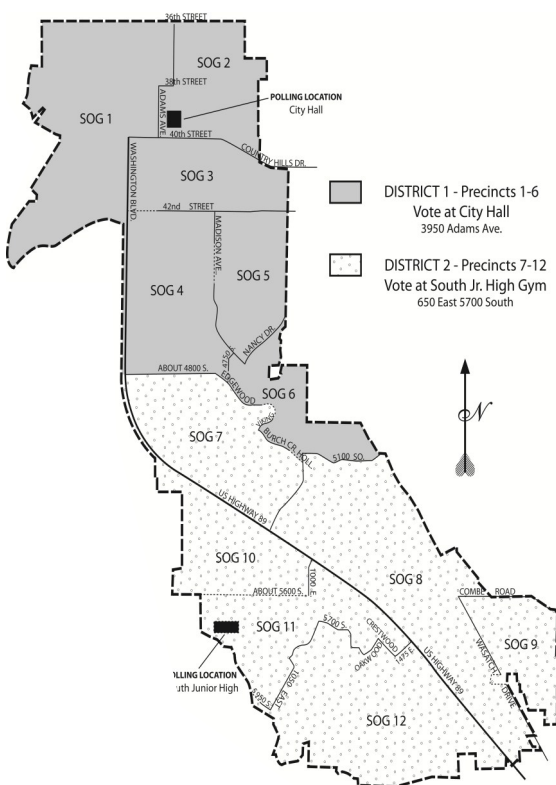

The gym is on the north side of the school and can be accessed from 700 East. Polls will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**Early voting** is a great way to beat election day lines. Early voting for all precincts will be held at City Hall from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on October 25 through 28 and November 1 through 4.
